




Minutes of EUSAPA Project Full Partner Meeting (OLOMOUC, 26-27.1.2009)

- **-TASK (ALL)** To distribute survey and gather data from representative sample of general schools with minimum number of returned SURVEYS from 20 schools, where they include students with disabilities (March 30, 2009).
- -TASK (UP) To prepare template for SPSS data analysis (March 30, 2009).
- -TASK (ALL) To enter data to prepared templates and send them to Milada Truksova (April 20, 2009)

6. APA survey in sports and recreation

- **-TASK (ALL)** To translate the survey to native languages (February 28, 2009).
- **-TASK (ALL)** To distribute survey and gather data from all national sport organizations both for persons with and without disabilities (March 30, 2009).
- -TASK (UP) To prepare template for SPSS data analysis (March 30, 2009).
- -TASK (ALL) To enter data to prepared templates and send them to Milada Truksova (April 20, 2009)

7. APA survey in rehabilitation

- -TASK (ALL) To translate the survey to native languages (February 28, 2009)
- **-TASK (ALL)** To distribute survey and gather data from representative sample of rehabilitation centers or hospitals representing variety of patients groups (orthopedic, neurological, respiratory, cardiac, psychiatric) minimum number of returned SURVEYS from 20 centers (March 30, 2009)
- -TASK (UP) To prepare template for SPSS data analysis (March 30, 2009)
- -TASK (ALL) To enter data to prepared templates and send them to Milada Truksova (April 20, 2009)

8. Project design (logo, marketing, PR) + Communication strategies (web site, conferences, media)

- Basic idea of project design and PR was presented by Ondrej JESINA. Partners agreed with using presented logo for developing all PR materials.
